TENDER FOR THE SALE OF FIELD LATEX IN KASARAGOD ESTATE

Competitive Sealed and E-tenders are invited for the sale of Field Latex in Kasaragod Estate for a period of One Year. Firms/Persons having a valid Manufacturer/Processor/Dealer License from Rubber Board can only be participated in the tender through Kerala e-portal (<https://etenders.kerala.gov.in>) and Direct Tender subject to the following terms and conditions.

Terms and Conditions:

A. Period of Contract

The period of contract will be one year from the date of Execution of Agreement.

B. Agency/Purchaser

1. Those who intends to take part in the tender, shall be a valid Manufacturer/Processor/Dealer License holder from Rubber Board.
2. The purchaser shall supply sufficient number of clean and empty barrels required for storing field latex at Kasaragod Estate. In addition to this, required quantity of ammonia in cylinder and other preservatives for latex preservation have to be supplied. The Corporation will not be responsible for the coagulation of latex stored in barrels due to old and unclean barrels.
3. The purchaser shall take delivery of the field latex from the station within five days of intimation by the Estate Manager and issue a receipt for the quantity lifted to the Officer in charge of the station.
4. Tare Weight and Code Number of the barrels supplied shall be recorded on the barrels by the Purchaser and the same shall be checked at the collection centres for confirmation. The filled latex barrels shall be weighed at the collection centres in the presence of the authorised representative of the Purchaser and Estate Manager. Statement with the details of Code Number, Tare Weight, Gross Weight and Net Wet Weight of latex shall be prepared and signed then and there, which shall be accepted by both the parties.
5. The weight/volume of the latex lifting from the Kasaragod Estate shall be considered as the final weight of that purchase. The Corporation will not be responsible for any loss in weight/volume during transportation/handling after taking delivery of the barrel as above.
6. The loading and transportation i.e., engagement of labours and vehicle shall be the responsibility of the purchaser.

C. DRC Estimation/Testing

7. For Dry Rubber Content (DRC) estimation, one sample will be taken from each barrel after thorough mixing. One homogenized sample will be taken from the above samples (from one truck load consisting of maximum 40 barrels) and the homogenized bulk sample will be divided into three specimens. The first specimen will be analyzed at the PCK Laboratory by Estate Manager; the second will be issued to the Purchaser and the third specimen will be kept at Office of the Manager., Kasaragod Estate. In case of any dispute, the third specimen will be analyzed in the presence of the Purchaser or his authorized Representative at PCK Laboratory and that will be final. Request for testing the third specimen shall be made within 30 days of taking the sample.

D. Selling Rate and Payment

8. The purchaser shall pay the value of latex calculated as per the contract rate to the Manager; Kasaragod Estate. The rate will be at a premium/discount accepted under the contract on the average latex price for 100% DRC at Kottayam during the **previous week of lifting** as published in the website of the Rubber Board.
9. **Advance:** The purchaser shall remit **Rs 8,000/-** (rupees eight thousand only) per barrel as advance before taking delivery of latex up to a maximum of **45** barrels. After getting DRC report, the exact price will be informed and the account of each consignment shall be settled at the contract rate within 10 days.
10. If the Purchaser fails to remit advance and settle the entire account within the stipulated time, Corporation is at liberty to cancel all consignments with the purchaser and to forfeit all amount remitted by the Purchaser and to conduct re-tender for the sale of the latex at the risk and cost of the Purchaser. All expenses loss incurred in this behalf will be on account of the Purchaser and Corporation have the right to recover the same with 25% interest from the Purchaser and their assets. In the event of such cancellation of consignments, the defaulted Purchaser will lose their eligibility to participate in the future tenders of this Corporation for a period of six months.
11. If the purchaser wants to lift more barrels over **45** Nos, shall remit advance to cover 95% of estimated sale price plus taxes for each barrel. If the Purchaser fails to remit advance and settle the entire account within the stipulated time, Corporation is at liberty to cancel all consignments and proceed as per 10th condition.
12. The Estate Manager shall issue GST Invoice to the Purchaser based on DRC for the field latex lifted. GST as per the Invoice shall have to be borne by the Purchaser and have to be remitted by the Purchaser along with the price of latex.
13. The purchaser shall issue necessary Statutory Forms prescribed under the "Goods and Service Tax" to enable the Corporation to comply with the assessment procedures under the relevant rules.

E. General conditions

14. Those who are interested to participate in the e-tender, have to download the work item from the e-tender portal and offer bid in the BOQ and upload it along with the scanned copy of the tender conditions after signed in all pages, fully filled tender form, Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Demand Draft for EMD in the above e-tender portal. The cost of tender form is Rs.118/- (Incl. GST) and same to be remitted through the portal. The bid shall be submitted through either above said web portal or sealed tender. The original Demand Draft for EMD and related documents to be submitted at Head Office or at Office of the Manager; Kasaragod Estate on or before 17.08.2023, 10:30 a. m. The last date for e-tender submission is **16/08/2023 at 2.00 P. M. and tender will be opened on 17/08/2023 at 2.30 P. M.**

15. Those who are interested to participate in sealed tender, party have to receive the tender conditions and tender form from Kasaragod Estate Office after remitting Rs.118/-(including GST) as cost of tender form and offer bid in the tender form and submit it along with the tender conditions after signed in the all pages, fully filled tender form, Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Demand Draft for EMD at Kasaragod Estate Office before the last date of bid submission. The last date for sealed tender submission is **16/08/2023 at 2.00 P. M. and tender will be opened on 16/08/2023 at 2.30 P. M. at Kasaragod Estate office.**

F. EMD & Agreement

16. **EMD of Rs: 50,000/-** (rupees fifty thousand only) shall be remitted in the form of **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of **Plantation Corporation of Kerala Ltd** payable at **Kottayam or through RTGS**. EMD related to the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded immediately.
17. **Security Deposit:** The successful tenderer on getting intimation of confirmation has to execute an agreement in Kerala Stamp Paper worth Rs.200/- within ten days on receipt of the intimation of confirmation after remitting **Rs: 1,50,000/- (rupees one lakh and fifty thousand only) as Security Deposit**. The security deposit will be refunded on expiry of the contract period subject to adjustment of any amount outstanding against the value of latex taken or for any losses or damages caused to the property of the Corporation during the course of lifting the latex from Kasaragod Estate. EMD remitted can be adjusted towards part of the Security Deposit.
18. The agreement can be rescinded by either party by giving two months notice in writing to the other party.
19. The Managing Director reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason thereof.
20. In case of disputes or doubts, the decision of the Managing Director, Plantation Corporation of Kerala Ltd, Kottayam - 4 will be final and binding on all.
21. All taxes duties and other levies if any, relating to purchase and transportation of latex shall borne by the contractor. The contractor shall indemnify and keep the Corporation indemnified against any such claims.
22. The jurisdiction regarding any dispute whatsoever between the parties in respect of this contract shall be exclusively with the Court having Jurisdiction at Kottayam only.
